VINEYARD

The 2011 Tesoro is from the three best vineyards that I could find. The Sangiovese is of the Brunelo clone from Pope Valley in Napa, Finished with organically grown Deerfield Syrah and Cassata Cabernet Sauvignon from Sonoma.

VINTAGE

This wine was made in the Super Tuscan style and barrel aged for fourteen months. The varietals were fermented separately and then blended four months before bottling. 52% Napa Sangiovese, 24% Deerfield Syrah, and 24% Cassata Cabernet Sauvignon.

TASTING NOTES

Enticing aromas of wild berry, dark cherry, fresh violets, cocoa, fine leather and cigar box. Rich flavors of brambly blackberry, cherry, cassis, black currant, roasted plum, dark chocolate, vanilla and subtle hints of spice on the palate. Nice supple tannins and smooth texture with a long, velvety finish. A great wine that tastes well young and will cellar for 7 to 10 years.
