TASTING NOTES

Our classic Italian-styled Pinot Grigio opens with aromas of stone fruits, melon, and tropical citrus. Crisp acidity, as well as high minerality lead in the palate along with flavors of nectarine and kiwi. This is a perfect wine to enjoy as an aperitif, or as a pairing with a variety of lighter and leaner dishes such as pesto pasta salad, cilantro lime shrimp, or grilled asparagus.
