Located in the Carneros AVA next to San Pablo Bay, our California Sangiovese is grown in a region sufficiently hot to allow full sugar and phenolic development while maintaining fresh acidity. The vines are cooled by morning fog and the influx of afternoon marine air.

TASTING NOTES

This brilliant new release is the epitome of what a proper blush wine should be. Light in body, color, and tannin, yet teeming with aromatics and flavor, concluded by a refreshingly crisp acidity. This Rosato offers an enticing bouquet of grapefruit, mandarin orange, and roses, with lofty flavors of strawberries, cherries, and watermelon. Enjoy this Rosato with tangy cheese, fresh fruit, prosciutto and heirloom tomatoes.
